




 Shift vehicle transmission into "PARK". Turn key to "OFF" position and remove from vehicle.

3. Preassemble front bumper with LH cap [P2], bracket cover [P4] and M4 x 16 screws [P7].




- 1. Front bumper [P1]

NOTE: The cage nut, on the other side of the support, must remain in place for re-installation.




- 1. Cage (elastic) nut

6. Position and install front bumper upper mounts through the rack front supports.













